The objective of STAR CRN is to robustly support comparative effectiveness studies, pragmatic clinical trials, health system innovation, and the other research needs of our stakeholders and partners.

- Encompasses eight health systems servicing three main regions: Vanderbilt University Medical Center, Vanderbilt Health Affiliated Network, Meharry Medical College, Duke University Health System, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, **Wake Forest Baptist Health**, Health Sciences of South Carolina, and Mayo Clinic.
- STAR CRN network consists of academic health centers, community hospitals and a range of outpatient practices including primary care, specialty practices and safety net facilities that serve diverse populations.
